



Bulletin for SCMA Members – July 2025

Happy Fourth of July Weekend! Hopefully you are at the rest and relaxation phase and all is well.

This is the first short form **bulletin** emailed to SCMA Members. Bulletins will be focused on a few topics primarily about our **RIDES**. The next full **newsletter** is due before the end of July.

FOUR CORNERS

This bulletin is about the USA Four Corners (4C). The new SCMA website www.sc-ma.com has a **History** tab for each of the rides and 4C History is [here](#). We are reviewing and assembling 4C documents to tell more of all the stories. We have posted all of the **Four Corners Finisher names since 1984** on the new website, available from this [page](#) where all Finishers and Awardees can be found.



The attached pdf has newly summarized number of 4C riders with some days ridden. The number of riders has varied each year. Even with the covid times the **annual average is 48 riders** with a wide range of riders from year to year. There are other details, for instance, numbers of the former tradition of husbands and spouses riding the Four Corners tour.

We have the number of days ridden on the Traditional 4C since 2005 and for the True X 4C since its introduction in 2011. Overall average number of days for **Traditional Four Corners is 16.1** and for **True X it's 19.4**. The Traditional Four Corners max allowed is 21 days for certification and for the True X in 26 days for certification.

Is your name on the Four Corners Finishers list yet? **There is a list of riders who have finished more than one Four Corners too.** The record holder has 20. There is a lot of space between 9 and 20.

Dannie Fox, the former Four Corners Ride Chair, retired from the chair position this year. He is still a member and involved the history archive projects. Watch for a profile article on Dannie in the next newsletter. Four Corners riders are in good hands with Rodney Chew and Charlie Lamb, both multiple Four Corners finishers. You can see how many in the attached.

RIDE CERTIFICATION

Remember the rules have changed and now riders should check out the Rules tabs on rides of interest, run their rides and submit the records for certification on the website. The Ride Chairs are available for questions.

48th THREE FLAGS in 2026
